An Act to amend the Health Act 2007 to grant the Health Information and Quality Authority (HIQA) the power to inspect all emergency homeless accommodation funded by the Department of Housing, Planning and Community and Local Government. The Act also grants HIQA the power to inspect direct provision centres funded by the Reception and Integration Agency (RIA) of the Department of Justice and Equality. 10

Be it enacted by the Oireachtas as follows:

Amendment of Health Act 2007

1. (1) The Health Act 2007 is amended

(a) by inserting the following after section 2 (1)(a): 15

“section 10 of the Housing Act 1988”;

(b) by inserting the following after section 2 (b):

“(c) that is a Direct Provision Centre as defined by the Reception and Integration Agency (RIA) ”;

(c) by inserting the following after section 2 (b)(ii): 20

“section 2(b)(iii) section 10 of the Housing Act in an amount that prescribed for the purpose of this sub paragraph”;

(d) by inserting the following after section 2 (b):

“(c) enters into an arrangement with the Reception and Integration Agency (RIA) to provide residential accommodation and ancillary services to asylum seekers in locations throughout the State”. 25

(e) by inserting the following after section 8 (1)(b)(i)(III):

(F) section 10 of the Housing Act 1988

(a) services provided by a direct provision centre as defined by the Reception and Integration Agency (RIA) ”; 30

(2) The Health Act 2007 is amended by inserting the following after section 8 (1)(m):

“(n) to inspect all emergency accommodation funded by the Department of Housing,

(o) to inspect all residential accommodation and ancillary services to asylum seekers funded by the Department of Justice and Equality through the Reception and Integration Agency (RIA),”.
