An Act to amend the Broadcasting Act 2009 to make it a breach of contract or licence under the Act to prohibit a member of the National Union of Journalists from communications media for reason or reasons of occupation, employer, or employment status. 5

Be it enacted by the Oireachtas as follows:

Amendment of Part 6 of Broadcasting Act 2009 10

1. Part 6 of the Broadcasting Act 2009 is amended by the insertion of the following section after section 78:

“78A. It shall be a breach of a contract or licence issued under this Part for a broadcaster to prohibit any member of the National Union of Journalists from its communications media for reason, or reasons of occupation, employer, company relationship or employment status.”. 15

2. This Act may be cited as the Broadcasting (Amendment) (Protection of Journalism) Act 2019.
